## **California Fish and Wildlife Strategic Vision to Hold First Meeting** *Executive Committee to Begin the Implementation Process of AB 2376 (Huffman)*

**SACRAMENTO** – The Fish and Wildlife Strategic Vision will hold its first public meeting to begin the implementation of AB 2376 (Huffman). The bill requires the California Natural Resources Agency to convene a cabinet-level committee to develop a strategic vision for the Department of Fish and Game and the Fish and Game Commission, and submit it to the governor and Legislature. This legislation is intended to establish a long-term goal to improve and enhance the Department of Fish and Game's capacity and effectiveness in fulfilling its public trust responsibilities for the protection and management of the state's fish and wildlife.
