Blue Ribbon Citizen Commission to Hold First Meeting

SACRAMENTO, Calif. – The California Fish and Wildlife Strategic Vision Blue Ribbon Citizen Commission (BRCC) will hold its first public meeting Thursday, July 21 at the State Capitol.
