California Fish and Wildlife Strategic Vision Project to Hold Series of Public Meetings

SACRAMENTO – The California Fish and Wildlife Strategic Vision (CFWSV) Project will hold a series of public meetings the week of January 9, 2012. The Blue Ribbon Citizen Commission (BRCC) and the Stakeholder Advisory Group (SAG) will meet jointly to discuss specific topics related to potential recommendations for a strategic vision. During meetings Jan. 10-12., members of the SAG will discuss science, compliance, statutes and regulations, governance, and funding, with guidance from BRCC members; these meetings are not expected to have a quorum of BRCC or SAG members.

For those not able to attend in person, participation in the meetings will be available via WebEx and teleconference. The meetings will be video archived, and made available for viewing on the strategic vision website.

On Jan. 12, the CFWSV Executive Committee will hold a public meeting to discuss progress of the BRCC and SAG discussions, receive a preliminary report on barriers that have prevented past recommendations from being implemented, and provide direction to the BRCC and SAG in developing recommendations for the interim strategic vision.
